Year 11 Compulsory Intervention Sessions

With the Year 11 summer GCSE season almost upon us, we have planned a comprehensive range of intervention sessions to support your child to reach their full potential and achieve their highest possible grade. These timely and well-planned sessions will run alongside the exam timetable on a daily basis, before and after school.

Breakfast intervention sessions will run from 8.00am and twilight sessions will run from 2.40pm until 5.00pm, commencing on Monday 13th May. Please note, the first hour of twilight sessions (2.40pm-3.40pm) is compulsory for all students who take that particular subject. Sessions will run fully staffed until 5.00pm for students who wish to stay. Please note there will be a late bus provision in place at 3.40pm, but suitable arrangements will need to be in place for students to travel home should they remain in school until 5.00pm.

If your child takes the subject which is the focus of the revision session that night, and fails to attend, they will face a sanction as per the school Behaviour Policy. It is expected that all students who take that particular subject attend all relevant intervention sessions.
