Re: Transition to 5 Houses


Over the last 4 weeks, the Baysgarth Community have been voting on how they would like the transition to 5 houses to take place for September 2021.

The views of the community are integral to this process as the House system is a fundamental aspect of life at Baysgarth School. The outcome of the community vote will decide the method in which we transition to the 5 House system in September 2021. The response from the community has been outstanding with over 884 people having their say, which reiterates just how important the House system is to students, staff and families.

The results show clearly that the preferred option with 53% of the vote is to have 5 new houses from September 2021.

On the 14th of December we will be launching a competition where we will be asking for your creative ideas on what the 5 new house names will be. The competition is open to everybody and entries can be as innovative and original as you want but we are looking for 5 house names that reflect our beliefs and vision here at Baysgarth School.

All entries will be assessed by the student and senior leadership team who will shortlist the best suggestions before a final vote will be launched again with our community.

We want as many students and families to get involved with this competition and as an incentive the winning idea will win a £100 voucher to spend at the Imaginarium Restaurant and Gastro Lounge at a time of their choosing for a family meal. This prize has been increased significantly thanks to the generosity of the owners of The Imaginarium Restaurant who did not hesitate to support us with this.
