

School Uniform Guidance

At Baysgarth School, our 3R values underpin everything we do. We want our students to be respectful, resilient and understand responsibility in school and within their local communities. Our school uniform is an important part of creating this identity and presenting a professional image. A high standard of personal appearance is expected of all students and staff. Professional attire and being fully equipped for learning are basic expectations of all members of Baysgarth School.

Uniform can be ordered from www.swischoolwear.co.uk, which is our sole supplier. Please do not order or purchase uniform from another company, as our uniform is bespoke to SWI. If you have any questions, please speak with the school.

Grey trouser or skirt suit (skirts must be two inches above or below the knee)
Standard white, loose fitting shirt with pointed collar and top button, which must be fastened
House or Prefect tie
Grey v-neck jumper (optional)
Black or brown belt
Plain black socks with trousers or thick black tights with a skirt (40 denier minimum)
Plain black with no material decoration or inserts, polishable, leather style formal shoe with no logos or branding, with a low heel or flat sole, as pictured. No UGG style boots, plimsolls, sandals or knee length boots. Ankle boots can only be worn under trousers.
Plain, dark coloured coat with no logos or branding

Standard white, loose fitting shirt with pointed collar and top button, which must be fastened
House or Prefect tie
Grey v-neck jumper (optional)
Black or brown belt
Plain black or white socks
Plain black, polishable, leather style formal shoe with no logos or branding, as pictured.
Plain, dark coloured coat with no logos or branding

Footwear Guidance

Acceptable

Shoes should be made of a polishable leather style material. They should be plain black with no material decoration or inserts and no logos or branding. They should be formal dress shoes appropriate to be worn with a suit.



Unacceptable

No leather trainers or branded shoes, including logos. Shoes should not have any material decoration or inserts, including suede, suedette or canvas detailing.
