Behaviour Policy Amendment

I am writing to inform you of an amendment the school has made to our Behaviour Policy, which takes effect immediately.

The school made the decision to completely ban aerosols from the school site. This is due to a recent incident, which resulted in the fire alarm being activated due to the inappropriate and excessive use of aerosols. This incident also caused disruption to a Year 11 GCSE examination, in addition to disrupting lessons for students in all other year groups. Furthermore, we have a number of students and staff who suffer from asthma and other respiratory related conditions. This ban will also serve to protect these students and staff from potential outbreaks of asthma attacks and/or suffering other medical issues.


To be very clear, the amendment to the Behaviour Policy now prohibits the use of aerosols on the school site at all times during the school day. If a student fails to comply with this, a sanction of a full day in Isolation will be issued.

The school advises that roll-on antiperspirants and pump action body sprays should be used as an alternative.
