Friday 7th September Arrangements

On Friday, 240 students from Year 8 to Year 11 will be going on a reward trip to Flamingo Land. Over the course of the 2017/18 academic year, these students demonstrated outstanding records for behaviour, attendance and punctuality.

Friday's visit will depart from the school's bus circle between 8.45am and 9.00am. Upon arrival to school, students taking part in the visit will need register in the Main Hall, where they will be divided into their bus groups. Bus lists have been displayed at Student Support and form tutors will be able to advise students which bus number they have been allocated.

The buses should return back to school by 5.30pm and parents are asked to make suitable arrangements to collect their child(ren). Students will be allowed to use mobile devices on this visit to contact parents to advise of changes to the time of arrival back at the school. We would ask that parents do not to park in the bus circle when collecting their child(ren) to minimise congestion.

Year 7 students and students in Years 8 to 10 not taking part in the trip will be involved in ICE (Identity, Culture and Ethics) sessions all day. These will focus on criminal justice for Year 8, mental health, knife crime, entrepreneurs, money management and writing CVs for Year 9 and 10, and GCSE preparation for Year 11 students.

In addition to this, we are very excited to announce that we will be launching Expert Learner programme for Year 7! We have worked in close partnership with Wren to produce fantastic logs for all Expert Learner and Flipped Learning work, which will be distributed during Friday's sessions.
