Monday 1st July 2019

We are delighted to be welcoming your child for their first formal day at Baysgarth. We hope that the Transition Youth Club has given you a good insight into the school, but this will be the first time that the entire year group will be together and students will get to experience a day in the life of a Baysgarth student; meeting key staff, using the dining hall, meeting their Tutor and experiencing assemblies. The day will end in an opportunity for parents to visit the school and meet the Head of House, Learning Manager and Tutor who will be responsible for ensuring your child's wellbeing and success throughout their time with us.

Pupils will come directly to Baysgarth School, wearing their primary school uniform. This year, due to change in school transport policy, it is the responsibility of all parents to ensure the student arrives at Baysgarth School by 8.20am. On arrival there will be students available to direct them to the Main Hall where we will welcome your child and oversee the programme for the day. They will have a tour of the school with pupils and experience a range of "normal" lessons with their House, in order to develop friendships. Your child will need to bring a pen or pencil with them.

For students eligible for free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided by the school; all other pupils are asked to bring a packed lunch.

We have had a number of parents who have not received some important information from us due to the wrong contact details being held by the school, which have been provided by the Local Authority. Please ensure your child's application form is completed and returned to us prior to the induction day next week. It is a legal requirement that we have contact details in case of an emergency.

Students are to be collected at 2.30pm; if collecting your child by car, please park on the road outside the school grounds (Barrow Road).

After the formal school day, there will also be an opportunity for you to meet your child's Tutor, Learning Manager and Head of House. These are the people who you will have most contact with during your time with us at Baysgarth and who will ensure that your child is happy and achieving their full potential.


