Summer Term Uniform Expectations

I am writing to reiterate our expectations with regard to school uniform during periods of warmer weather.

As we reach the period of the year where the weather, and therefore the school, can be very hot, it becomes difficult for us to enforce the wearing of blazers at all times in the school corridors. Our Student Council has raised this issue with senior leaders at the school and we have agreed that we will introduce a summer uniform for the last six weeks of the school year.

From Monday 10th June blazers will be optional for students, but all other items of uniform remain compulsory. In line with our policy, students are expected to wear the following at all times:

- House tie with top button fastened
- School uniform suit trousers OR school uniform skirt with black tights (minimum 40 denier)
- Black polishable shoes, NOT trainers
- Long or short sleeved white collared shirt, which should be tucked in at all times

Please note, shirt sleeves should not be rolled up and students wearing them in this manner will be sanctioned.

Our usual expectations in regard to jewellery, hair and makeup remain in place.

Once we start the new school year in September, blazers will once again be compulsory and any student not wearing a blazer will be sanctioned.
