Dear Parents and Carers

Year 7 Induction and House Activity Day

As part of your child's induction we are organising two key events in September, which will support your child in becoming a member of the Baysgarth community.

Friday 6th September will be a day focusing on being a Baysgarth citizen and we will be exploring the Baysgarth journey and what your child should expect to experience during their time with us. During this day we will also launch the Expert Learner and Flipped Learning programmes. Sessions will be delivered in Houses but the day is based in school and will follow normal school times.

Friday 13th September 2019 will be a House team building event off site at Elsham Activity Centre. This day is a great opportunity for children to make new friends and socialise with people who have not come from the same primary school and start to integrate into their House and have fun. It is also a key time to share expectations and character traits we expect from all students at Baysgarth.

Students will be expected to be on site as normal at 8.25am, where they should report to the Main Hall to be registered. The trip will leave at 8.30am from school and students will travel to Elsham via coach.

Students are not expected to wear school uniform but should wear loose fitting clothing that will not matter if this becomes muddy and dirty. A change of clothing would be recommended in case we get wet during the day. Students are reminded that there should be no inappropriate slogans or attire and clothing should be suitable for the activities involved.

Students should bring a small rucksack or bag and ensure they have a water bottle for the day. Energy drinks are not permitted on the trip. Any student who has a mobile phone will be expected to keep this in their bag at all times and they are not to be used unless there is an emergency.

Students will be expected to bring a packed lunch for the day; students who receive a free school meal will have lunch provided.


The trip will return back to school at 4.00pm to allow students to get the full benefit of the activities. We would ask parents to collect students where possible, but there will also be a late bus in place to transport students home who cannot be picked up by their parents/carers.

The trip has been subsidised and is available at a reduced price of £15 per student. This is a voluntary contribution but if sufficient funds are not received then the trip may not be able to go ahead. If any parent has any issues funding the trip but would like their child to take part, please do not hesitate to contact me so we can discuss how we can help.
