Your New School Uniform

At Baysgarth School we develop a sense of PRIDE in our community and a sense of belonging. The school uniform is an important part of creating this identity and presenting a professional image within our local community. A high standard of personal appearance is expected of all students and staff. Having a professional attire and being fully equipped for learning are a basic expectation of all members of Baysgarth School and we look forward to welcoming your child to our school community in September.

The basic uniform consists of a grey trouser or skirt suit, white collared shirt, tie and black polishable shoes (information previously included with Welcome Letter). In order to support parents with ensuring the uniform they purchase meets our uniform code our uniform is available through one supplier only Sports Wear International. They are the **only** stockist of the Baysgarth suit and any other blazer or trousers will not be acceptable.

If you are in doubt, then please contact your child's Tutor to discuss **before** purchasing items.

Parents are required to visit the website www.swi.co.uk and register their child for an account as soon as possible. The uniform can then be purchased directly from the company and delivered directly to your home. In addition, we are offering the opportunity for you to come in with your child to try on uniform and speak to experienced staff, either on **Wednesday 12th June** or **Thursday 20th June 4.00-5.30pm**. Payment for the uniform is made via the website, directly to Sports Wear International.

If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium the school will provide 50% funding towards your child's basic uniform pack (blazer, two trousers or skirts, PE kit). In the coming weeks you will receive a payment voucher for this amount which you can use on the SWI website. If you have not returned your admission forms which asks for this information, then please ensure this is done promptly otherwise the voucher cannot be issued.

SWI provide a delivery service which includes free delivery to the school. If you chose this option then please contact the main reception to check your order is at school before coming to collect it. Please be aware that the school will not be open throughout the summer holiday period. Further details on opening times will be sent to parents nearer the time.
