Students should arrive at the venue between 7.00pm and 7.30pm and the evening will conclude at midnight. It is expected that all students attending will arrange their own transport to and from the venue.

I am also delighted to confirm that the total cost of the Prom this year will be £40 per ticket; this includes a three-course meal, drinks on arrival, a DJ and other great surprises.

There is the flexibility to pay the £40 in instalments, as long as the full balance is paid by the aforementioned date.

Mediterranean Vegetable Penne Pasta


#### Dessert
